Dear Valued Customer.

The Johnson Controls Fire Suppression business continues to manage material costs to mitigate the effects of inflation in our supply chain. Unfortunately rising raw materials and energy costs persist and these significant cost increases are expected to continue.

Therefore, we are implementing an 8% price increase effective on all new Water & Mechanical orders starting August 15, 2022 with the exception of CPVC which will be 0%.

Effective August 15, we will also adjust our pricing policy for certain products that are exposed to chemicals, resin, and other highly volatile commodities. Due to our inability to predict future cost for certain raw materials we will make real-time adjustments to product pricing, for both open and new orders, if we are unable to mitigate cost increases from our supply base.
